Ms. Selma is special. She knows everybody.

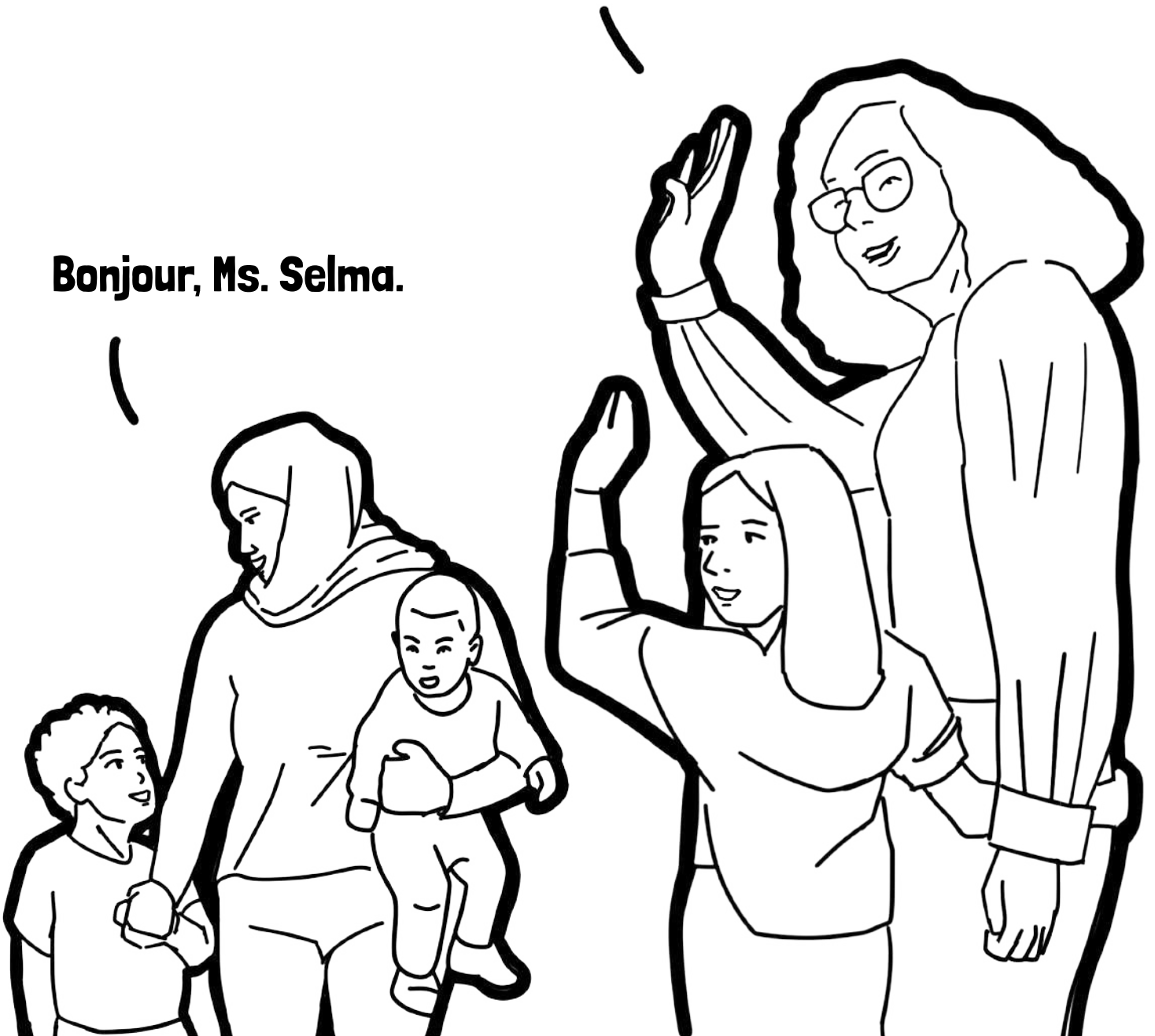
¡Hola, Ms. Selma!

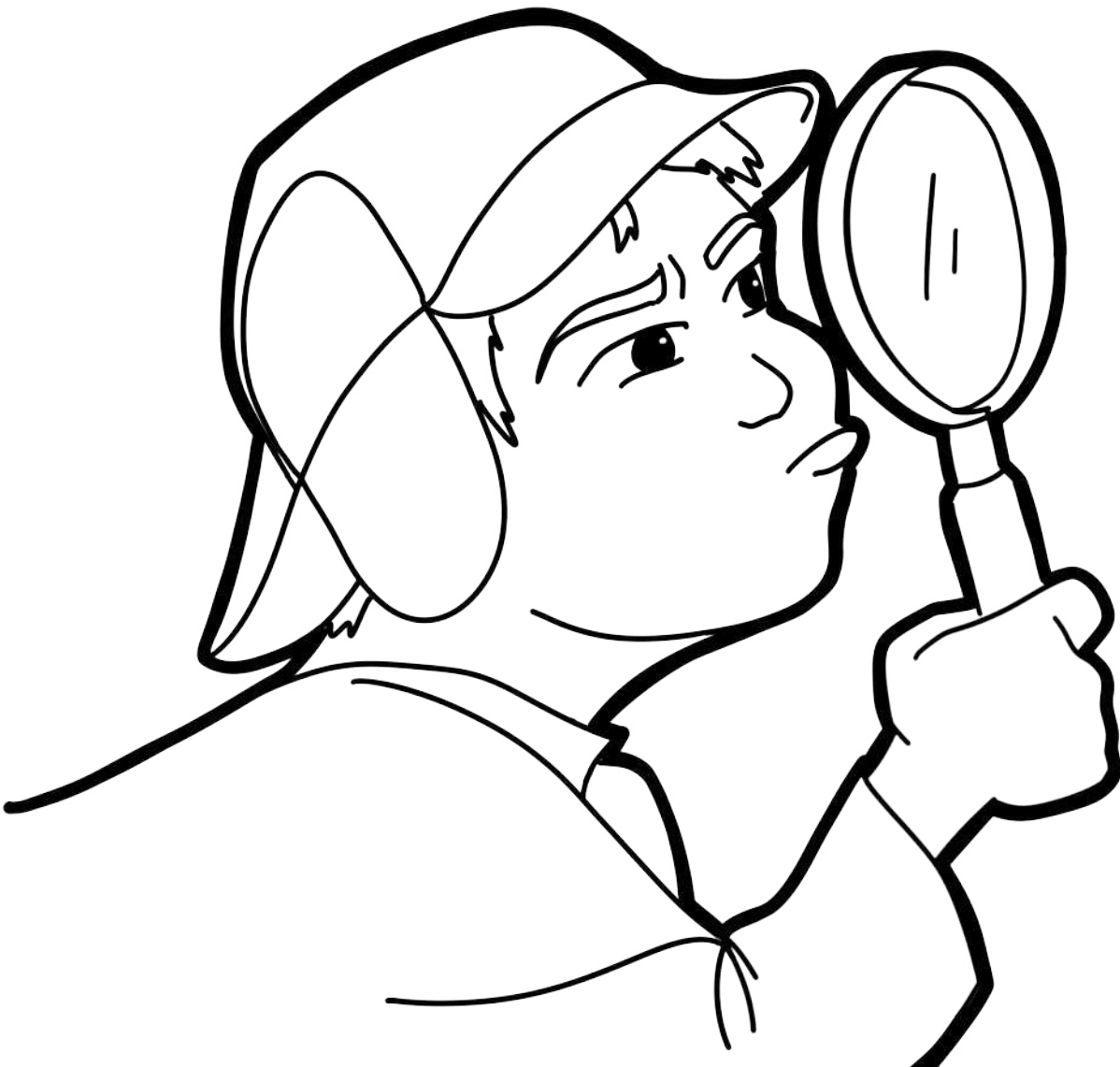


So there I was, spying like a secret super agent.

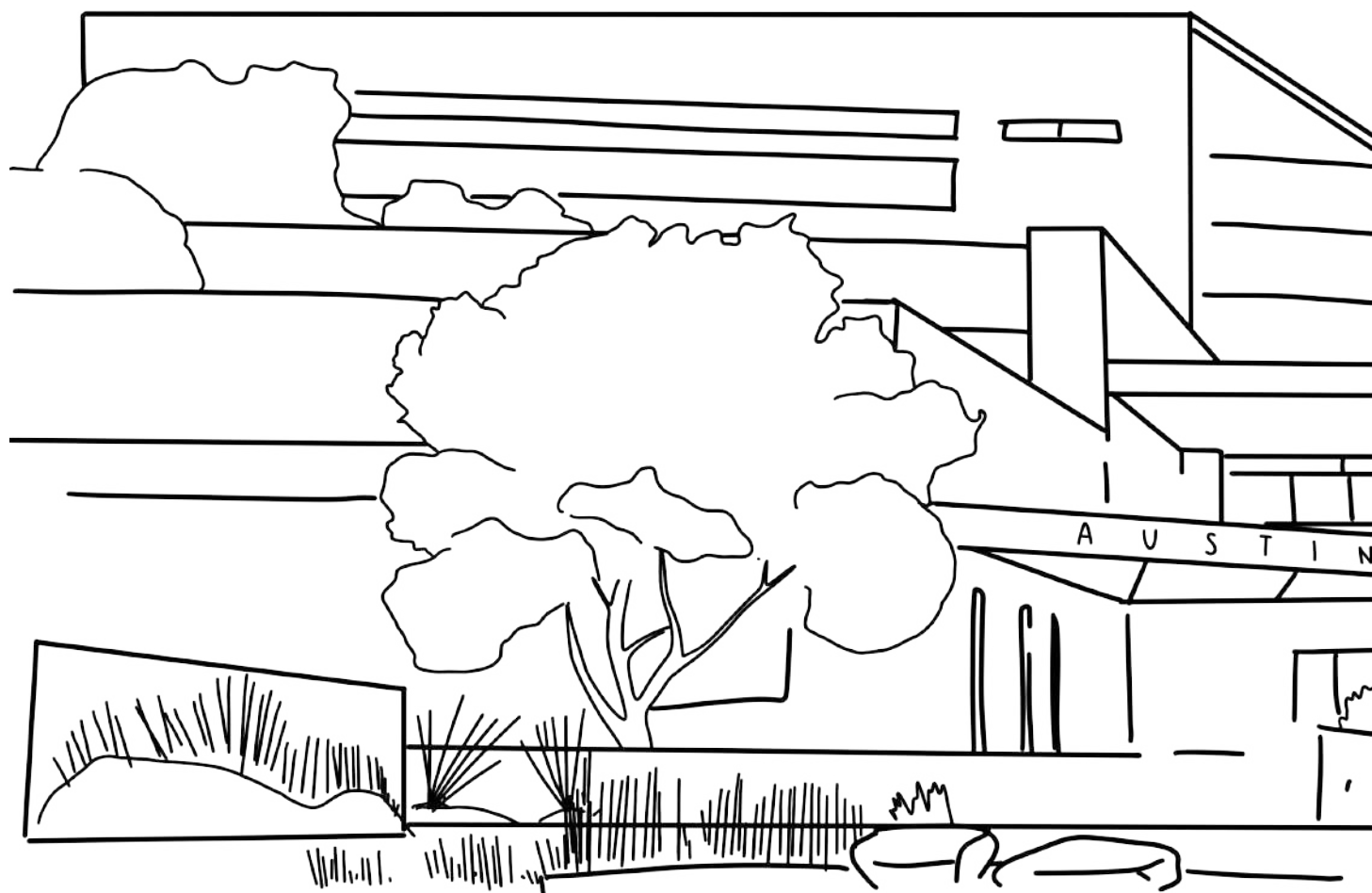


"I have an idea, Ms. Selma! I will tell Mom, and we can call the neighbors and my friends."
